Enquiry report filed by respondent No.2 in Court, is taken on record.

2. In pursuance to the order dated 11.03.2015, District Magistrate, Sonapat directed Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), Sonapat to enquire into the matter and submit his report. Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), Sonapat constituted a committee comprising of Tehsildar, Labour Officer, District Food & Supply Officer and Incharge, Police Station Rai. The said committee visited the place of alleged detention i.e. Mark Kush Bhattha, Village Kheri Barota, District Sonapat on 13.03.2015 and made inquiries.

3. Fact finding inquiry conducted by said committee reveals that Singh Ram petitioner himself left the Bhattha four days ago. The labourers mentioned in the petition came to the brick-kiln about four months ago and they were working on their own will. There was no complaint against brick-kiln owner. The report further reveals that even the labourers as shown in the petition have left for their home on 13.03.2015. Nothing was due towards the labourers. The committee has also observed that the labourers have also been provided basic facilities by the owner.

Without adverting to the merits of the case, this Court is of the opinion that since the alleged detainees have gone to their houses on their own, no further order is required to be passed and this petition has become infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
