Neither the order dated 24.04.2015 has been complied with,
nor the learned arguing counsel for the petitioner has come present.

From the reply filed by the State, it is evident that on the
instructions of the District Magistrate, the Sub Divisional Magistrate,
Raikot constituted a team of four officials, who visited the brick kiln in
question on 09.01.2015. Statements of the persons present there
including the owner of the brick kiln were recorded to the effect that
neither the petitioner nor the alleged detenues, whose names have been
mentioned in the petition, ever worked at the brick kiln.

In these circumstances, the present petition being devoid of any merit, is hereby dismissed.
