RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed by the mother of alleged detainee Satinder Kaur. This Court vide order dated 17.03.2015, passed the following order:-

“This criminal writ petition in the nature of Habeas

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Corpus has been filed by mother of alleged detainee Satinder Kaur.

In view of nature of allegations made in the petition, notice be issued to respondent No.3 calling upon him to make earnest effort to get the detainee released. Respondent No.3 is directed to produce detainee-Satinder Kaur in this Court on 27.03.2015.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Pradeep Prakash Chahar, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy of this petition has been handed over to Mr. Chahar for further necessary action.”

Respondent No.5 has filed reply to the petition stating that the respondent No.5 and Satinder Kaur have solemnized marriage on 10.03.2015 and thereafter, both filed CRM-M No.8396 of 2015 seeking protection qua their life and liberty .

In the aforesaid CRM, this Court passed the following order dated 13.03.2015

“The case of the petitioners is that they are major and have contracted marriage on March 10, 2015. The marriage certificate and the photographs evidencing marriage have been placed on file. It is alleged that they apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 6. To seek redressal of their grievance, they have submitted representation dated 11.03.2015 (Annexure P-4) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Panchkula.

Notice to respondents No.1 to 3, only at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Charanjit Singh Bakshi, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Copy of the petition be supplied to

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learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the age of the petitioners and validity of the marriage, directions are given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Panchkula, to decide the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P-4) within one month from today, keeping in view the threat perception to the petitioners.

However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.

The petition stands disposed of.”

Today the respondent No.5 and Satinder Kaur have also appeared in person, who were duly identified by Mr. Fariad Singh & Mr. Swaran Singh, Advocates and denied the averments made in the petition.

Without commenting upon the validity of the marriage, this Court considers that in view of aforesaid, no further orders are required to be passed in this case.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of.
