This complaint was received in the Secretariat of Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice. The complainant has alleged that her husband is serving as a driver and the police has registered false cases of theft against him. On 03.01.2015, her husband made a call on her mobile phone that he had doubt about the contemplated action of police in arresting him at any time. Thereafter, no intimation was received by the petitioner and till date whereabouts her husband is not known.

Notice of motion was issued and in pursuance to the said order, learned counsel for the State has filed a reply by way of affidavit of Jaswinder Singh PPS, ACP (Crime) Ludhiana dated 24.02.2015.

As per reply, the husband of the petitioner is not wanted in any case nor he has been arrested by CIA Staff, Ludhiana in any case. The allegations are claimed to be false. In view of the reply filed by the State counsel, no action is required to be taken in the present petition.

Thus, the petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
