Rekha Mittal, J. (Oral)

The precise grievance of the petitioner is that he has submitted an application dated 14.11.2014 (Annexure P1) to the Superintendent, District Jail, Karnal for grant of furlough, but no action has been taken thereon despite expiry of more than two months.

Keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioner that the authority concerned may be directed to consider and dispose of the application filed by the petitioner, without meaning to express any opinion on merits of the controversy, the petition stands disposed of with direction to the Superintendent, District Jail, Karnal to dispose of the application of the petitioner in accordance with law, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
