Learned UT counsel submits on instructions from SI Gurdev Singh that statements of the sister of petitioner i.e. alleged detenue and respondent No.5 were recorded on 29.3.2015. The girl has no apprehension of threat to her life and liberty. She is married to respondent No.5-Suraj and is major.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parents should atleast be permitted to meet their daughter.

The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondents No.2 and 4 that on appearance of the parents of

petitioner and making application in this regard, these respondents would ensure that the parents are able to meet the girl at the place where she is residing by deputing a police team including lady police official.
