Reply by way of short affidavit of Gurdev Singh Dhaliwal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-II, Patiala has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. The same is taken on record. Copy supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. The reply suggests that one Jagroop Singh son of late Harnek Singh, resident of House No.13-E, Street No.1, Anand Nagar-A, Patiala has filed a complaint bearing No.1222/5A dated 18.3.2015 against Harwinder Singh son of Makhan Singh, resident of House No.1, Gurdeep Colony, Patiala and Avtar Singh son of Chanan Singh, resident of Village Rampur Khurd, Tehsil Rajpura, Patiala alleging therein that they have connived with each other and had played a fraud upon him of Rs.20,00,000/-. Another application was also

received from the complainant Jagroop Singh, which is marked as Annexure R2/T and it is in the aforesaid circumstances the parties came present in the police station on summoning and ASI Jagroop Singh tried to settle the dispute amicably. Since Avtar Singh, father of the petitioner was not ready to return the amount, both the parties were produced before the SHO of Police Station, Tripuri, Patiala. However, in the reply, it has been stated that three different FIRs were registered against Avtar Singh, father of the petitioner, which are as under :-

- “a) Case FIR No.33 dated 17.1.1984, under Section 160 IPC, Police Station Ambala City. In the said case Avtar Singh was convicted to undergo 10 days rigorous imprisonment and Rs.70/- fine.
- b) Avtar Singh was convicted 9 months R.I. and Rs.1000/- as fine in case FIR No.28 dated 29.4.1980 U/s 279, 304-A IPC, Police Station, Banur.
- c) Case FIR No.10, dated 1.2.2015, U/s 406, 420, 120-B IPC has been registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala against the Avtar Singh (father of petitioner) and others. The said case is under investigation with the Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala.

Considering the fact that the detenues have already been released and there are cases against the father of the petitioner, no further action is required to be called for in the present case.

Disposed of.
