The criminal writ petition has been filed for grant of six weeks' emergency parole to the petitioner to enable him to get proper treatment from Kesar Hospital, Rewari or some other well equipped institute at Chandigarh. The petitioner was released on furlough for 2 weeks on 01.03.2015. During this period according to the certificate (Annexure P-1) he was operated upon for Fistulectomy on 03.03.2015 and discharged on 04.03.2015. According to the certificate he required rest for daily dressing which are to be done twice a day for next three weeks. After furlough, it is stated that, the petitioner has surrendered in jail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the criminal writ petition for the

present and approach the jail authorities for emergency parole in the first instance.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
