The petitioner has filed this petition for the grant of emergency parole of at least four weeks.

It has been averred that while the petitioner was on emergency parole earlier, he got married with Sukarman Preet Sandhu on 26.11.2014 who is permanent resident of Canada. It is further averred that the petitioner wants to spend more time with his wife who will leave the country at the end of February, 2015, therefore, the petitioner may be granted emergency parole for one month more.

Reply has been filed by way of affidavit of Surinderpal Khanna, PPS, Superintendent, Central Jail, Ludhiana on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. The same is taken on record.

It has been averred in the reply that two months before, the petitioner was granted six weeks emergency parole which has already been availed by him. There is no provision in the Act to grant emergency parole to the petitioner further, for the purpose of family

planning.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, we are of the considered view that the petitioner has already enjoyed the concession of emergency parole for the period of six weeks as stated by the learned State counsel. Hence there is no ground to grant emergency parole to the petitioner further, petition is accordingly dismissed.
