Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to produce the detenue namely, Lakhwinder Kaur, daughter of the petitioner, who is stated to have illegally detained by respondent No.4 by solemnizing illegal marriage with her.

Para 4 of the petition suggest that respondent No.4 has solemnized marriage with detenue namely, Lakhwinder Kaur. Para 4 of the petition reads as under :-

“4. That thereafter as per the information with the petitioner, the respondent No.4 has solemnized marriage with the detenue on 14.3.2015 at Shri Gurudwara Sahib, Village Thuthianwali. Thereafter, respondent No.4 had taken her in the District Court,

Mansa and filed a protection petition vide CRM No.21 of 18.3.2015 titled as 'Lakhwinder Kaur and another vs. State of Punjab and others', which was listed on 19.3.2015, which is now pending for 17.4.2015.”

In view of the fact that respondent No.4 and detenue Lakhwinder Kaur have already approached the District Court, Mansa and have filed protection petition, which is listed for hearing on 17.4.2015, no order is required to be passed in this petition by this Court.

The criminal writ petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application before the District Court, which shall be considered in accordance with law.
