Reply by way of affidavit dated 2.5.2015 of Deputy Superintendent of Police, NRI & Women Wing, Jalandhar-2 filed on behalf of respondent No.3 in the Court today is taken on record and copy thereof has been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Rajender Kumar, Police Station, NRI Kapurthala, submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as the alleged detainee Pardeep Kumar has been arrested on 29.4.2015 in FIR No.6 dated 31.7.2014 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station

NRI, Kapurthala. Thereafter he was produced before the Illaqa Magistrate on the very next day, i.e. 30.4.2015, rendering the instant petition as infructuous.
