In the reply filed on behalf of the respondents, it has been stated that the relief sought by the petitioner has already been granted to him and he has been paid his entire pensionary benefits after regularizing his period of absence from duty.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that as per acknowledgment annexed with the reply, the petitioner has received a cheque dated 16.04.2015 amounting to ₹720552/- on account of Pension/Commutation/Gratuity and as per another acknowledgment dated 01.05.2015 the petitioner has received an amount of ₹77247/- on account of leave encashment. As per these acknowledgments, the petitioner is fully satisfied with the payment and calculation therein and has stated that the civil writ petition may be withdrawn.

This fact was recorded in order dated 08.07.2015 and notice was issued to counsel for the petitioner. Thereafter, the matter was listed on 24.09.2015. No one appeared for the petitioner on that date and today again no one appears for the petitioner.

It appears that as per acknowledgments (Annexure R-1), petitioner has received his claim and is fully satisfied. So, no further action is required.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
