During the course of day, the case was called several time but no one appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

It is to be noticed that the present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. It is a habeas corpus petition seeking release of the detainees, mentioned in para 3 of the petition.

On 31.03.2015, this Court had directed the District Magistrate, Jalandhar to look into the matter and get the detainees released in the event of their illegal detention.

Reply on behalf of respondent No.3 has been filed indicating that needful has been done and the alleged detainees have already gone from the brick kiln. Seven persons were found present on the spot, who stated that they have received the money in lieu of the work done by them.

Therefore, the present petition is rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
