Report of the Warrant Officer has been received. He has mentioned that the detenue Kamaljeet Kaur was not found present in the house. Despite undertaking given by Numberdars of the village, Jagjit Singh (respondent No.6) and his wife Sarabjit Kaur that they will produce the detenue in Police Station Sadar after sometime, the detenue was not brought by them.

Mrs. Kamaljeet Kaur has appeared in the Court today with the petitioner. It is submitted that she was produced before the Station House Officer of the concerned police station on the next day i.e. on 05.04.2015 after the visit of Warrant Officer and from there she had accompanied her husband-petitioner Varinderpal Singh, who too is present in the court.

Mr. Sanjeev Goyal, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondents No.4 to 7 as well as Avtar Singh, father of alleged detenue Kamaljeet Kaur. Learned counsel on behalf of respondents No.4 to 7 and Avtar Singh submits that they have no objection to the marriage of their daughter with petitioner Varinderpal Singh.

Mrs. Kamaljeet Kaur, who is present in Court voluntarily states that she wants to accompany her husband to the matrimonial home. Since she is a major lady, she is allowed to do so and the petition is disposed of accordingly.
