Learned State counsel has filed reply in the shape of affidavit of Rajinder Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rajpura, District Patiala. It has been stated in the affidavit that Manpreet Singh resident of Canada was neither required by the Police of District Patiala in any case nor his house was raided on 26.03.2015 at about 5.30 am. It has also been denied that the CCTV Camera and hard disc etc were taken in custody by the police of Baddowal, District Ludhiana.

However, it is submitted that a written complaint was given by Gurjit Singh s/o Surat Singh resident of Waraich Farm, Village Asmanpur, Tehsil Pehowa, District Kurukshetra now Phase 9, Grewal Avenue, Bhadson Road, Patiala. After inquiry, First Information Report No.202 dated 13.09.2014, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code was registered at police station, Rajpura City in connection to the said case ASI Malvinder

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Singh after making an entry of his departure vide DDR NO. 26 dated 26.03.2015 at 3.00 am, had gone to village Baddowal, District Ludhiana and had conducted a raid for apprehending Yadwinder Singh Grewal and Harpal Singh Grewal, both residents of Baddowal.

In any case, as reported by the State counsel upon instructions from ASI Malvinder Singh, neither Manpreet Singh was required in any case nor he was forcibly detained by the police.

In view of the above, the present petition is accordingly disposed of.
