Learned State counsel has submitted that as per information received by him the spot was inspected and the persons mentioned in para 4 of the petition were found working at the brick kiln but they were not bonded labours. The owner of the brick kiln had no objection to their going to their native village. All these persons expressed their desire to leave and left the brick kiln in vehicle bearing registration No.PB-32-P-7675.

2. In view of the submissions made by the learned State counsel this petition has since become infructuous and the same is dismissed as such.
