Response by way of an affidavit dated 15.05.2015 of the Station House Officer, Police Station Lalru, District SAS Nagar (Mohali), has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. A complete copy of the same has been furnished to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Perusal of the reply as also the statements recorded of the alleged detainee Sarabjeet Kaur as also of her mother Baljinder Kaur would make it apparent that Sarabjeet Kaur is a minor, her date of birth being 20.12.1997 and it has been categorically stated that she is staying happily with her mother

as also brother and she does not know any boy by the name of Ashok Kumar (present petitioner) and has never even met him.

In the light of such stand taken on behalf of State, the instant petition filed seeking issuance of writ of Habeas Corpus, is dismissed.
