RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.

Grievance of the petitioner is that respondent No.2 has not processed the case of agricultural parole of the petitioner and has not sent the same to respondent No.3 for verification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon instructions dated 7.4.1999, wherein the District Magistrate is obligated to verify the parole case within 21 days and then the Superintendent of Jail can consider the parole case within five days and ultimately the Director General of Prisoners has to decide the parole case within ten days of its receipt.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Pradeep Prakash Chahar, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Copy

of the petition has been supplied to him.

On consideration of facts, respondent No.2 is directed to process the case of the petitioner for grant of parole. Without expressing anything on merits at this stage, on such process, the case shall be decided by the authorities in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of.
