The response by way of affidavit of the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana has been filed.

It is categorically denied that the family members were detained illegally. However, they were being questioned with regard to the investigation on the complaint made by Jaffeer and the parties were proceeded against for security proceedings under Sections 170, 151 Cr.P.C. It is further submitted by learned State counsel on instructions from SI Rajwant Singh that in FIR No.54 dated

08.04.2015 under Sections 363, 366-A IPC, Police Station Meharban, Ludhiana, brother of the petitioner was wanted as an accused and has been arrested yesterday.

Therefore, no further indulgence of this Court is required.
