The petitioner stands convicted for an offence punishable under Section 302 read with Section 34 IPC. He was also accused for an offence punishable under Section 42 of the Prison Act, 1894 but he stands acquitted in the said case.

The petitioner has sought parole to attend the wedding of his two sisters scheduled to be solemnized on 02.05.2015.

Learned counsel for the State states that it has been verified that in fact the marriages are fixed on 02.05.2015.

In view of the said fact, the petitioner is ordered to be released on parole to the satisfaction of the competent authority for one week. He shall surrender on or before 08.05.2015.

The present petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
