Prayer in this petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to get released the detenues detailed in Para No.3 of the petition, who are stated to be in illegal confinement of the respondents No.4 to 6.

Report of the Warrant Officer has been received, who has mentioned that when he visited the brick kiln there were about 100 labourers working at the brick kiln out of which 35 labourers stated that they have not been paid daily wages and they wanted to leave because they had some dispute with other labourers. The owner (respondent No.4) and his Munshi (respondent No.6) did not object to the release of the labourers, rather they provided conveyance to them and the labourers were allowed to

leave. It is also mentioned that Rs.10,000/- was paid by brick kiln owner to the petitioner.

Reply filed by learned State counsel on behalf of respondents No.1 and 3 is taken on record.

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner today. In view of the report of Warrant Officer, no further direction is required and the petition is dismissed.
