All the thirteen petitioners claiming themselves to be 1984 riot victims and alleged to have been issued Red Cards by the State of Punjab, have filed this petition seeking direction to the respondents to allot flats to them as per the policy of allotment of houses/booths to the Sikh riot affected families, as applicable in the case of the petitioners.

It is the case of the petitioners that in this regard, they have submitted a representation dated 03.04.2014 to the Government, copy of which has been annexed with the petition as Annexure P-11.

Mr. Dhuriwala, who is appearing on behalf of the State of Punjab, states that after verifying the claims of the petitioners (except petitioner No.10, who is not a resident of the State, but a resident of Union Territory, Chandigarh), the State Government has forwarded their aforesaid representation to the Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (GMADA) – respondent No.3 for considering their case for allotment of flats to them under the aforesaid policy.

Learned counsel for GMADA - respondent No.3 states that the representation forwarded by the State Government is pending consideration before GMADA – respondent No.3. He states that decision on this representation will be taken within a period of three months from today, by passing a speaking order, and the same will be communicated to the petitioners accordingly.

In view of the stand taken by the respective parties, we dispose of this petition with a direction to GMADA – respondent No.3 to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners (except petitioner No.10) by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months.
