Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of the respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for grant of six weeks emergency parole to enable him to provide admission fee, dress material and books etc. to his son as he is admitted to 2nd class.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that when his genuine grievance was not being redressed, he finally approached Superintendent, District Jail, Bhiwani-respondent No.4 by way of representation dated 15.04.2015 (Annexure P-1) but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case respondent No.4 is directed to consider and decide his application in view of the order dated 28.01.2014 passed by this Court in CRWP-1785-2013 (Harjinder @ Bittu Vs. State of Harayana and others) Annexure P-7 within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, Superintendent, District Jail, Bhiwani-respondent No.4 is directed to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 15.04.2015 (Annexure P-1), at an early date and in any case within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law and keeping in view the order dated 28.01.2014 passed by this Court (Annexure P-7).

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
