MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition where the petitioner prays for appropriate directions to respondent No.3 to delete the names of the private respondents by correcting the mutation and for registration of a case etc. after holding an inquiry.

The petitioner herself has expired after filing this petition as has been stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner. She during her life time suffered a decree in 1985 and now alleges fraud after a lapse of 30 years and prays for correction of the entries in the revenue record.

On due consideration of the matter, I would not comment on the merits of the case which led to the transfer of the property of the deceased petitioner but suffice it to say that the

petitioner has adequate remedies in law by moving the authorities on the revenue side or the civil court for getting the decree set aside in case she or her legal legal heirs can establish such a fraud.

No ground to interfere.

Dismissed.
