Response by way of affidavit dated 29.5.2015 of Assistant Commissioner of Police (Crime), Ludhiana has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

Perusal of the reply would reveal that the following stand has been taken on behalf of the State with regard to the alleged detenue Rajinder Kumar husband of Suman Bala.

“That the fact of the matter is that on 30.4.2015, ASI Sukhdev Singh alongwith other police employees was present in connection with patrolling duty at Ganda Nala when the husband of the petitioner was apprehended with 20 grams of Smack and accordingly FIR No. 34 dated 30.04.2015, under Section 21 of NDPS Act, P.S Division No. 3, Ludhiana has been registered against the husband of the petitioner and information about the arrest of the accused was given to the present petitioner. The Arrest Information Memo was also duly signed by the petitioner. Thereafter, the husband of the petitioner/accused was produced before he Ld. Magistrate on 01.05.2015 who further remanded the accused in police custody. Thus, the husband of the petitioner has been arrested in the above noted FIR. It seems that the present letter has been sent just to create some false defence.”

In the light of such information having been furnished, no further directions are required to be passed.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands disposed of.
