In this petition criminal writ petition prayer was made to release the detenue namely Poonam from illegal detention of respondents No.4 to 6.

Notice was issued on 12.05.2015. A status report submitted by Satya Pal, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dabwali has been filed in which it is submitted that Poonam is wife of respondent No.4-Subhash. There is apparent matrimonial discord between couple. FIR No.81 dated 08.03.2015 under Section 346 was got registered against present petitioner Rajesh Kumar son of Sher

Singh. In turn one FIR No.101 dated 24.03.2015 was registered at the instance of brother of present petitioner against respondent No.4/husband of detenue for the offence under Sections 147, 149 and 364 IPC.

In earlier FIR, Police has submitted a cancellation report, however the second FIR No.101 dated 24.03.2015 under Sections 147, 149 and 364 IPC is still pending.

Petitioner also filed one **CRM-M No.11628 of 2015**, in which this Court vide order dated 09.04.2015 directed respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Sirsa to look into the grievance in accordance with law.

Taking stock of aforesaid facts, since the alleged detenue is in her matrimonial house, her presence in matrimonial house cannot be termed to be illegal detention. For rest of *inter se* grievances between the parties, a direction has already been issued by this Court to respondent No.2 to look into the affairs.

In view of aforesaid, no further orders are required to be passed in this case.

Disposed of.
