Prayer in this petition filed under Section 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to get released the detenues mentioned in the petition, who are in illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 7.

Report of the Warrant Officer has been received, who has mentioned that when he visited the brick kiln, there were labourers roaming freely and they stated that they wanted to leave. The owner of the brick kiln did not object to the release of the labourers and the labourers left the premises alongwith their belongings in two trucks.

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner today. In view of the report of Warrant Officer, no further direction is required and the petition is dismissed.
