The petitioner was earlier granted parole in February, 2015, as stated, and the same ended on 08.03.2015. He had applied for extension, but vide order dated 11.03.2015 fresh parole for six weeks was granted as he had already surrendered.

Now, the petitioner, who is to surrender tomorrow, i.e. on 21.05.2015, has applied for extension so that he can look after his wife and the infant, as his wife delivered a child on 29.04.2015.

The petitioner is already on parole practically for more than three months having surrendered only for three days in between. No ground for extension of parole is made out.

Dismissed.
