A complaint received by post was treated as a petition. Notice was issued to the Advocate General, Punjab, for today.

The allegations of the petitioner in the complaint are that Santosh is his legally wedded wife. She had left the matrimonial home with the minor daughter Komal Kiran. She was not born out of the wedlock. She was born from the loins of the petitioner from his earlier marriage with Nisha.

Santosh, who had allegedly kidnapped Komal Kiran, as per the allegations in the complaint, is present in person in Court. She stated that when the petitioner solemnised marriage with her, it was not disclosed that he was already married and is living with Nisha. The daughter was born out of that wedlock.

Reply by way of short affidavit of Ravinder Pal Singh Sandhu, Assistant Commissioner of Police (West), Jalandhar, dated 7.6.2015, filed in Court, is taken on record, in which it has been stated that the matter is pending before the Women Cell at Amritsar, where the parties are likely to settle the same.

Ravinder Pal Singh Sandhu, Assistant Commissioner of Police (West), Jalandhar, who is present in person in Court submitted that the petitioner was asked to be present in Court today, however, he refused.

Considering the aforesaid factual matrix, no further action is required to be taken in the present petition. The same is accordingly disposed of.
