ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

A writ in the nature of mandamus is prayed for, so as to direct the respondents to send the petitioner for training to Upper School Course, which was slated to commence with effect from 10.08.2011 at P.A.P. School, Phillaur, District Jalandhar. And persons junior to the petitioner were being sent and for no reason, least plausible, petitioner was ignored.

Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the parties suggest that petitioner had made a comprehensive representation to the Director General of Police, Head Quarters, Armed Forces, Jalandhar Cantt., dated 25.06.2011 (Annexure P-5), and an order thereon was yet to be passed, but in the meanwhile, petitioner preferred the petition in hand. They submit that let this petition be disposed of only with

a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the said representation (Annexure P-5) within a specified time.

That being so, and without expressing any opinion on merits, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner, as set out in his representation dated 25.06.2011 (Annexure P-5), strictly in accordance with law, within a period of three months of receipt of certified copy of this order.
