Prayer in this petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for release of detainee Gaganpreet Kaur daughter of petitioners, who is said to be in illegal confinement of respondents No.4 to 10.

Reply in the form of affidavit of Ravinder Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Tohana, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 has been filed. It is mentioned in the reply that the detainee was recovered by the warrant officer and was handed over to the petitioners. It is also mentioned that the detainee (Gaganpreet Kaur) and Sumit Kumar (respondent No.4) had filed a petition before District and Sessions Judge, Fatehabad, seeking directions to the Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad, to protect their life

and liberty. The said petition was allowed by the Sessions Judge vide order dated 20.03.2015.

Copy of the order of Sessions Judge, Fatehabad dated 20.03.2015 and a certificate of marriage, according to which detainee (Gaganpreet Kaur) and Sumit Kumar (respondent No.4) had married on 29.01.2015 has been produced on record by Shri Arun Sharma, Advocate who has appeared on behalf of respondents No.4 to 10.

Though the veracity of the documents is disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners but he concedes that the detainee is now with her parents.

In terms of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the instant petition is disposed of.
