Reply on behalf of State filed by way of affidavit, is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that vide Rapat No.05 dated 05.05.2015, Rahul along with Sandeep Kumar and Rahul Gandhi were taken for interrogation after conducting raid at Village Narot Mehra. After interrogation they were handed over to Partap Singh on 05.05.2015. Rahul was found to be in possession of 200 gms Intoxicant Powder and FIR No.61 dated 06.05.2015 under Section 21/22 of NDPS Act, Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot, District Pathankot was registered. Rahul is in custody in that case. As such, Rahul is not in any illegal custody as alleged by the respondent.

In view of the above, present petition is not maintainable and same stands dismissed.
