RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Inspector Parvesh Chopra, Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar, submits that detainee has been traced and her statement has been recorded. He further submits that in her statement recorded on 05.06.2015, Harmanpreet Kaur-minor daughter of the petitioner (alleged detainee), has stated that she has left home at her own and Satnam Singh-respondent No.4 has no role to play, in this regard. After having been traced, alleged detainee has been kept in Nari Niketan, Jalandhar. The detainee has stated that she as well as Satnam Singh-respondent No.4 are facing threat to their life and liberty.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, present petition is disposed of, with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar-respondent No.2 to look into the matter, take necessary action and ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of Ms. Harmanpreet Kaur-minor daughter of the petitioner as well as Satnam Singh son of Lakhwinder Singh-respondent No.4.

Let the alleged detainee-Harmanpreet Kaur be released from the Nari Niketan, Jalandhar. Respondent No.2 shall further ensure that if the alleged detainee wants to go to her parents, she shall be escorted to her parental house and if she does not want to go, she shall not be pressed, in this regard.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
