In this petition, petitioner seeks issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the officials respondents to get release the detinue namely Rajbir Kaur from illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 8. Warrant Officer was appointed who visited the spot and has submitted a report dated 30.05.2015. According to report, Warrant Officer found Rajbir Kaur in the house who claimed herself to be above 18 years of age and has married Harpreet Singh son of Kulwant Singh on 05.08.2015 of her own will. Warrant Officer recorded the statement and found that custody of Rajbir Kaur in the house of her husband is not illegal. Today the alleged detinue Rajbir Kaur, her husband Harpreet Singh and parents-in-law Kulwant Singh (father-in-law) and Rani (mother-in-law) are present in Court. They have assured well being and happy living of Rajbir Kaur in the matrimonial house.

At this stage, without commenting upon validity of marriage and the assurance given by aforesaid persons, this Court is of the opinion that since Rajbir Kaur is living happily with Harpreet Singh and his family with her own free will and further in view of report submitted by Warrants Officer no further order is required to be passed in this petition.
