Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Rashpal Singh, Police Station Kulgari, District Ferozepur, submits that Lakhwinder Singh @ Lakha son of the petitioner Smt. Sukhwinder Kaur was neither wanted in any criminal case nor he was, as a matter of fact, picked up by the police officials including the police officials of Police Station Kulgari, District Ferozepur on 20.05.2015 at 6.00 AM, as wrongly alleged in the present petition. He further submits that in fact, Lakhwinder Singh @ Lakha had gone to some dera without informing his parents and he returned back on the next day. However, before he returned, instant complaint was moved by his mother Smt. Sukhwinder Kaur-petitioner.

Two affidavits (in Punjabi) dated 02.06.2015 of Lakhwinder Singh @ Lakha as well as his mother Smt. Sukhwinder Kaur-petitioner, filed in the Court today, are taken on record.

Learned counsel for the State submits that in view of the abovesaid facts, present petition does not survive and the same may be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
