On a petition for production of the detenues through a writ of habeas corpus this Court had appointed a Warrant Officer to inspect the station house office-respondent. Warrant Officer has returned a report stating that he had carried out inspection of the police premises and found that there was no presence of the alleged detenues. He has collected information that criminal complaint has been registered against the detenues along with other persons. Reply has been filed by the State through Surinder Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sardulgarh which details the registration of complaints against the detenues and also sets out the information that one of them Baldev Singh, detainee No.2 has since been apprehended on 01.06.2015 and the other detenues are still at large

Having regard to the fact that the registration of criminal complaint is brought on record, the respective detenues as affected persons have liberty to approach appropriate forum for regular bail or anticipatory bail, as the case may be. No other directions are necessary in this writ petition.

With these observation, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty as aforesaid.
