A written request sent by petitioner-Salwinder Singh was treated as petition on judicial side, wherein, notice of motion was issued.

In response to notice of motion, reply on behalf of respondent-State has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. As per reply, son of the petitioner is not wanted in any case by the police of Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar. Neither the son of the petitioner is arrested nor illegally detained by the Police and no complaint is pending against him as on today. It is also mentioned that against the alleged detainee, one case i.e. FIR No. 427 under Sections 21/22 of NDPS Act was registered on 22.11.2014 and in that case he is on bail.

Keeping in view the stand taken in the reply, there is no merit in the petition and the same is dismissed.
