The petition for *habeas corpus* has been taken *suo motu* on a complaint received from the petitioner by Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice that her husband is kept under illegal confinement. On notice to the State, the Deputy Superintendent of Police, City Gurdaspur, has given reply by way of affidavit that the petitioner's husband is kept in confinement for possession of narcotic substances after registration of FIR No. 46 dated 29.05.2015 under Section 21/22/61/85 of NDPS Act. The affidavit also disclose that three other cases have been registered, out of which in two cases the petitioner's husband is reported to have been convicted and in the 3rd case the trial is still in progress.

The confinement would therefore appear to be just, proper and under adequate legal process. There could be no room for setting him at large.

The petition is dismissed.
