CRM-19195-2015

This is an application for staying the recovery of fine.

Recovery of fine shall remain stayed during the pendency
of the appeal.

CRM-19196-2015

This is an application for suspension of sentence of the
applicant-appellant during the pendency of the appeal.

The trial Court vide judgment dated 2.6.2015 has
convicted the applicant-appellant for an offence punishable under
Section 22 of the NDPS Act and vide separate order of even date,
sentenced the applicant-appellant as under:-

Sr.No.	Name of convict	U/s	Sentence
1	Suraj Singh	22 of the NDPS Act.	Rigorous imprisonment for a period of one year and to pay fine of Rs.10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand only) and in default of payment of fine, rigorous imprisonment for a further period of fifteen days.

Learned counsel for the applicant-appellant submits that
as against the awarded sentence of 01 year, applicant-appellant is in
custody for 04 months and 19 days and there is no other case
against him.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate
and does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

Considering the fact that the appeal is not likely to be cropped up for final hearing in near future and as against the total sentence of 01 year, the applicant-appellant is in custody for about 04 months 19 days, sentence of the applicant-appellant is suspended during the pendency of the appeal, however, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar.
