As per office report, notices issued to respondent Nos.4 to 6 have not been received back served or otherwise.

Detenue Reena is present in the Court today along with petitioner Jony. She is identified by the petitioner. She has stated that she had married the petitioner and thereafter her parents (respondent Nos.4 to 6) had taken away her from Ferozepur. There she was beaten up. On 25.01.2015, she escaped from the custody of her parents and came back to Chandigarh and contacted the petitioner through phone. Now she is living with the petitioner.

Since, detenue Reena stands released from the custody of respondent Nos.4 to 6, therefore, the present habeas corpus petition becomes infructuous.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.
