Mr. Deepak Sabharwal, learned Addl.AG, Haryana accepts notice. Copy of the complete paper book be supplied to Mr. Sabharwal, during the course of the day.

Present petition has been filed for releasing the petitioner on parole for four weeks for performing the last rites of his grand mother namely Rampyari who died on 30.5.2015.

The case of the petitioner is that he is in custody in case FIR No. 378 dated 3.8.2013 under Sections 376, 506 IPC and 4/6 of POSCO Act PS Manesar Gurgaon. The petitioner has been convicted by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurgaon vide the order dated 26.2.2014 and 28.2.2014. A Criminal Appeal No. 1744-SB of 2014 preferred by the petitioner is also pending before this Court.

A representation has been filed by the petitioner to Superintendent of Jail for performing the last rites of his grand mother. It is submitted that the last rites are to be performed on 12.6.2015.

Accordingly, it is directed that respondent No. 2 shall take action on the representation dated 1.6.2015 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same by 12.6.2015.

Petitioner shall be informed regarding the said decision for supplying the copy of the order and in order to facilitate the petitioner's presence for the last rites ceremony of the grandmother on 30.5.2015, the respondent No. 2 shall also ensure that the petitioner is taken to his village for the ceremonies to be performed on 12.6.2015 in time. In the meantime, in case, the decision on the representation of the petitioner is in favour of the petitioner, he shall be entitled to his parole and he shall fulfil all the requisite conditions. In case the decision is against the petitioner, he shall be brought back to the Central Jail, Ambala, after the ceremonies are done.

Petition stands disposed of.
