This is a petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the release of the detenu-Meena Kumari.

Vide order dated 10.06.2015, this Court had issued direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana to secure the presence of the detenu-Meena Kumari from the alleged illegal custody of respondent No.4, in order to produce her before this Court.

The detenu-Meena Kumari has been produced today before this Court by ASI Gurcharan, Sr. No.1880, Police Station, Focal Point, Ludhiana.

The detenu-Meena Kumari has wished to join her matrimonial home.

Respondent No.4-Kishori Lal, father of the detenu, stated that he has no objection, in case, his daughter wants to join her matrimonial home.

In view of the aforesaid statements of detenu-Meena Kumari as well as her father-Kishori Lal at bar, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition.
