Prayer in the present petition is for extension of parole to the petitioner for a period of four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is already on parole upto 15.6.2015 and has to surrender on 16.6.2015. As his wife has to undergo heart surgery, he prays for extension of parole because the surgery has been deferred.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, we do not find any merit in the present petition at this stage. The petitioner was earlier granted parole by the authorities to enable him to get treatment of his wife, however, as per the latest certificate of the doctor, she could not be operated upon being unfit for operation anesthetically. No specific date has been given. She is on medication.

Considering the fact that there is no specific date given for operation of the wife of the petitioner, the parole already granted cannot be extended.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed
