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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner claims that he has solemnized marriage with Jyoti on 15.02.2015 in accordance with Hindu Religious Rites. Smt. Jyoti was major at that time. They already filed Crl. Misc. No.M-5301 of 2015 seeking protection of their lives as they apprehended danger because they had contracted the marriage against the wishes of their parents. That petition was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 16.02.2015 with direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarntaran to consider the representation moved by the petitioners and take necessary action in accordance with law. Thereafter, Smt. Jyoti had stayed with the petitioner for some time.

It is alleged in the petition that the private respondents had forcibly taken away Smt. Jyoti on 12.06.2015 at about 8.00 PM. Hence, this Habeas Corpus seeking directions to the respondents to produce Jyoti.

Notice of motion was issued on 16.06.2015 and respondents No.4 to 9 were directed to produce Smt. Jyoti in Court for today.

In response to the order dated 16.06.2015, Smt. Jyoti is present in Court and states that she is legally wedded wife of the petitioner, who is present in the Court and wishes to stay with him.

Mr. Gurpreet Singh, the petitioner states that he is willing to take Smt. Jyoti from this Court itself. He further states that keeping in view the sensitivities of the parents and other relations of the girl, he would reside at Khadoor Sahib.

Accordingly this petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
