Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Vipin Kumar, submits that there is land dispute between Sham Singh and others mentioned in headnote of the complaint and the complainant Kuldeep Singh, Mangal Singh, Jugraj Singh and Jasbir Singh. Civil litigation regarding that dispute is pending before the Court wherein order has been passed in favour of Sham Singh and others. As Mangal Singh, Jugraj Singh and Jasbir Singh were interfering in the possession of the Sham Singh and others the police has presented kalandra under Section 107/151 Cr.P.C. against them. The aforesaid persons are not required by the police in any other case and no case has been registered against them.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel no further action on the complaint is required. Accordingly, the same is disposed of as infructuous.
