S. J. VAZIFDAR, ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

The limited relief sought in the present writ petition is that the property be not auctioned till the petitioner's application for interim relief in the appeal, filed by the petitioner before respondent No.2, is decided.

2. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents has raised various contentions. One of the contentions is that the appeal itself has been disposed of on 16.01.2015.

3. The petition is, therefore, disposed of by the following order:-

If the petitioner's appeal before respondent No.2 is pending and if the application for interim relief is made therein, the bids, in the auction already held or which may be hereinafter held, shall not be confirmed till the

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disposal of the interim application or till the disposal of the appeal itself whichever is earlier and for a period of two weeks after the passing of the order. In the event of the appeal or an interim application not being pending before respondent No.2, there shall be no order in this petition. The petitioner is, however, always at liberty to adopt appropriate proceedings including for interim relief. A copy of the order, if any, disposing of the said appeal as alleged by the respondents shall be served upon the petitioners' Advocate in this writ petition forthwith.

4. Needless to say that the petitioners are at liberty to challenge the order, if any.
