Application is allowed, as prayed for, subject to all just
exceptions.

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1. There is a challenge to the order passed by the Deputy
Commissioner in the writ petition appointing an Administrator and
for a direction to hold election as per the rules. There had been an

interim stay of the operation of the order by an order of this court. It appears subsequently a fresh election has also been held. In the light of a subsequent event, there is no necessity for an adjudication of the validity of the order passed and more particularly when the direction to hold election after appointing an Administrator had not been given effect to by operation of the order of stay granted by this court.

2. I record the subsequent event of election as having taken place and any person aggrieved by such an election would be at liberty to file an election dispute in the manner contemplated by the provisions of the Societies Registration Act as applicable to Punjab.

3. With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of.
