Prayer in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to allot plinth level sites out of the land with respondents to the present petitioners at the rate which was prevalent at the time of allotment of co-allottees.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he wants to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a detailed and comprehensive representation to the authorities. Further prayer was made that directions may be issued to the respondents for disposal of the representation within time bond frame in the event of filing of the same by the petitioners.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. In case the detailed and comprehensive representation is filed by the petitioners, the same shall be decided by the respondents expeditiously by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
