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Mahesh Grover, J

The petitioner had impugned her order of transfer on the plea that repeated transfers were being effected without any justification.

While issuing notice of motion status quo order was passed and three years have lapsed thereafter. Considering the fact that the status quo order was passed which has remained effective for three years, the petitioner would have enjoyed the benefit of posting at one station during this period.

In the considered view of this Court, the petition has outlived its utility. By virtue of the interim order, the petitioner has no vested right to continue at one place and since three years stay at one place on account of the interim order has lent sufficient stability to her posting. I am of the opinion that the present writ petition needs to be disposed of leaving the respondents to their administrative decisions in matters of transfer etc., if the situation so warrant.

Ordered accordingly.
