By this writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the transfer order dated 13.05.2015 (Annexure P-3).

Counsel for the petitioner states that a representation made by the petitioner was forwarded by the Deputy Commissioner Jhajjar to respondent No.2 on 14.5.2015 (Annexure P-4), and that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the said representation without insisting on the implementation of the impugned transfer order in the first place.

I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the recommendation letter (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law within two

weeks from the receipt of a certified copy of this order, and till then it is directed that the impugned transfer order shall remain in abeyance.
